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## Double-Counting Policy

### 1. Context

The W+ Standard may be applied in a wide variety of project types. Projects may have multiple W+ domain application opportunities. Projects may have different activities over different time-frames (crediting periods). The application of the W+ Standard may result in the generation of W+ Units or W+ labelling. This policy strives to provide flexibility and clarity to project implementers while preventing the double-counting and thus the double-monetization of W+ activity outcomes.

### 2. Policy

Project implementers may not count W+ activity outcomes for monetization, as either W+ units or as W+ labeled units, more than once per crediting period. W+ Units shall be separate and distinct from W+ labeled units. Project implementers shall describe in the PIN and PDD documents:

- a) Their intention to generate either W+ Units, or
- b) W+ labeling of other units or project outcomes,
- c) For each W+ domain being applied, and
- d) For what crediting period.

Project implementers shall describe in their Monitoring and Evaluation Report(s) the specific methods employed to prevent double counting, including but not limited to:

- a) Describing scopes and boundaries of W+ project activities
- b) Describing attribution criteria for W+ activities that have multiple benefits to ensure that outcomes are attributed to only one project activity.
- c) Which W+ domain(s) are being applied, for either W+ Unit generation or W+ labeling of other types of units, for each crediting period.
