Brief narrative description of the project location	The Bokpoort Project is a 50MW Concentrated Solar Power (CSP) farm located in near the town of Groblershoop, 120 km South East of Upington in the Northern Cape Province, South Africa. This is the largest and most sparsely populated province of South Africa; Groblershoop has a population of less than 10,000.		
	The economy of the Northern Cape relies heavily on two sectors, namely mining and agriculture, which employs about 57% of all employees in the province. The Northern Cape also has a substantial agricultural area around the Orange River, including most of South Africa's sultana vineyards. The presence of perennial river water contributes to the establishment of table grapes, which are marketed and exported to Western Europe. Unemployment still remains a big issue in the province. Water shortages and energy access are also problems faced in this arid and semi-arid environment.
